BEST MAGAZINE ARTICLE—FIRST QUARTER 1949

James G. Randall again receives first honors for the Best Magazine Article on Abraham Lincoln appearing in periodicals during the first quarter of 1949. His contribution published in the New York Times Magazine for February 6, 1949 entitled "Lincoln's Great Declaration of Faith" was selected for this high honor by the Lincoln Foundation Advisory Group. The same distinction was accorded him in 1947 when his monograph "Great Unanswered Questions About Lincoln," appearing in a February issue of the same magazine, was given the preference over other Lincoln essays. the preference over other Lincoln essays.

Mr. Randall developed a thesis which is well put in Mr. Randall developed a thesis which is well put in the subtitle: "In two inaugural addresses the Civil War President has left the nation the essence of his philosophy." The author finds that these addresses of 1861 and 1865 reveal that Lincoln avoided sectional bitterness, but emphasized tolerance, humanity, justice and peace. The timeliness of Dr. Randall's arguments and conclusions are observed when we view the restlessness of the sions are observed when we view the restlessness of the modern world because of nourished hatreds and the lack of those virtuous attitudes to which Abraham gave the emphasis.
